Riot


270 incidents so far

- Website launched on August 30th with 40 photos
- To date, there are 77 photos posted
- Of the 80 people who have either turned themselves in or been arrested, 28 are as a result of the website

- New photos will be added as criminal activities are confirmed
- •This does not count the images that will be retrieved from the 1600 hours of video to be processed at the LEVA lab







LEVA

- LEVA lab will process 1600 hours of video from Sept 25th to Oct 10th
- Conventional methods would have taken IRIT nearly two years with existing resources



LEVA

- Once video is processed by LEVA, additional offences involving the same suspect can be identified
- This will assist in proving the essential elements of rioting
- Video evidence will provide a full picture of all alleged offences committed by suspected rioters.



LEVA

- Securing LEVA video evidence for turn-ins will be a priority so charges can be forwarded to Crown
- IRIT investigators are anxiously awaiting an opportunity to view the video once processed at the lab before completing the recommended charges to Crown
