Re: Records Access Request

We are replying to your request for information that was received in our office on April 26, 2016. In that request, you sought access to the following:

- 1) "The total number of sexual assaults reported to the Vancouver Police Department between 2005 and 2015 and the geographic breakdown of these reports (i.e. which neighbourhood each report occurred within);
- 2) How many of these sexual assault reports resulted in charges being laid; and
- 3) Where charges were laid, how many resulted in successful convictions".

We conducted our search using the following criteria:

- Stats Canada definition of sexual assault (please see page two of this letter);
- All offense method;
- · Reported date (not date of occurrence); and
- All reported sexual assault (founded and unfounded).
