VANCOUVER POLICE DEPARTMENT **CADET PROGRAM**



The VPD Cadet Program provides students in Grades 10-12, living in or attending school within Vancouver, a unique opportunity to participate in applied educational workshops, physical training, recreational activities, community service, and drill. Cadets develop skills in teamwork, leadership, mentorship, and are exposed to a variety of basic law enforcement skills, which can use throughout their everyday lives. Cadets get an inside look at different police units, including the Marine Unit, Mounted Squad, Canine Unit, Traffic Section, and Gang Crime Unit, to understand how they work together to serve and protect Vancouver residents. The purpose of the program is to instill life skills, leadership, confidence, and respect for themselves and others.

Class 10 of the VPD Cadet Program will commence September 2023, and be held weekly on Saturdays until the middle of May 2024.

- Will be starting **Grade 10, 11 or 12** within the Vancouver School District in September 2023 **and/or** live in the City of Vancouver
- Must be between the ages of 14-17 at time of application
- Have good attendance at school and goals of graduating
- Want to have fun, work hard, and participate in team activities
- Want to improve your physical fitness and health habits
- Want to make new and lasting friendships
- Want to make your community a better place
- Want to learn skills and methods to succeed into your future
- Looking for a challenge and willing to step outside of your comfort zone

Attendance Policy:

The VPD Cadet Program consists of 28 Saturdays and four Wednesday evenings throughout the year, two overnight camps. Attendance is mandatory and communication from cadets is expected. You will be required to have a Facebook account to communicate with instructors and classmates.

School Requirements:

The VPD Cadet Program requires cadets to be enrolled in school. The program encourages cadets to work hard, pass their courses, and to have excellent attendance at school. Note: A Homework Help Club and Fitness Club is offered to assist cadets every second Wednesday evening. Participation is optional but encouraged.

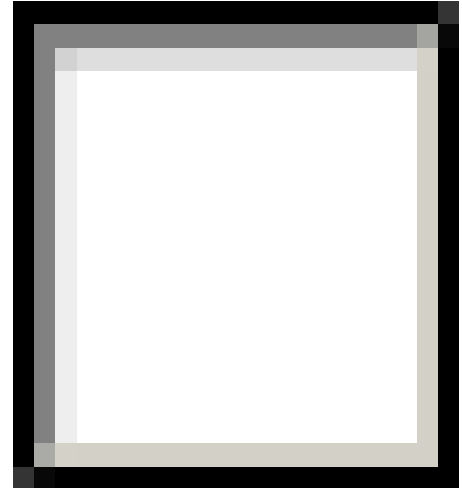

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ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK, WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY

In this document "VPD" refers collectively to the City of Vancouver, Vancouver Police Board, Vancouver Police Department and its officials, officers, employees, trainers and representatives (collectively, the "VPD Group").

I am aware that my signing this document is a condition of my Child being eligible to participate in the VPD Cadet Program (the "Program") which participation may be cancelled by the VPD at any time without prior notice or hearing. I am aware that my Child's participation in the Program will not entitle them to any payment nor salary, or other compensation or prizes of any kind to be provided by the VPD for my Child's participation as a volunteer.

I am also aware that as a participant, my Child is not an employee of the VPD and am not entitled to Workers Compensation Board benefits and my Child is not entitled to any medical, disability or other insurance benefits or coverage of any kind.

I am also aware that my Child's participation in the Program does require a certain level of physical health and ability and that I accept and bear full responsibility for my Child's physical health and ability to participate in the Program and that the VPD has advised me to consult my Child's family physician prior to participating in the Program.

NOTICE TO PARENT/GUARDIAN

I acknowledge that it is a condition of my Child's participation in the Program that I, the undersigned Parent/Guardian of the Child, must carefully read and understand this document and sign it to acknowledge that I have read and understand it and that I understand that my Child's participation in the Program will expose the Child to risks of harm and that I accept full responsibility for exposing my Child to such risks.



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PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITY FOR CHILD

I, the undersigned Parent/Guardian of the Child, understand and accept that, in respect of the Child's participation in the Program, it is my responsibility (1) to ensure that I consider and understand the risks, dangers, hazards and consequences of injury inherent in the Program, both those inherent prior to the COVID-19 pandemic and those additional risks imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic, (2) to determine, taking into consideration those risks and the Child's behavioral characteristics, physical health and abilities, whether the Child should be allowed to participate in the Program, (3) to ensure that the Child is appropriately covered by medical insurance for any harm occurring in the Program, and (4) to provide emergency medical information regarding the Child as required in this document.

AWARE OF RISKS

I AM AWARE OF AND NOW FREELY ACCEPT AND ASSUME FOR ME AND MY CHILD'S FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ALL RISKS TO MY CHILD IN CONNECTION WITH MY CHILD'S PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM, INCLUDING AS FOLLOWS: (1) my Child's participation in the Program, even if my Child possesses behavioral characteristics, physical health and abilities appropriate for the Program, poses risks of harm to my Child; (2) the nature of the Program is such that the VPD Group cannot identify all risks associated with the Program and cannot guarantee that VPD staff participating in the Program will not make errors therein or that other children participating in the activities will not cause injuries therein others that staff can or might be able to prevent.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED PARENT/GUARDIAN, AM THE PARENT AND/OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF MY CHILD AND FOR MY CHILD I HEREBY CONSENT TO THEM PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM, AND, FOR MYSELF AND THE CHILD, IN RETURN FOR THE VPD GROUP ALLOWING THE CHILD TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM:

1) I NOW WAIVE ALL LEGAL RIGHTS TO SUE AND ANY AND ALL CLAIMS which I or my Child or our respective successors and assigns may have against the VPD Group in connection with any loss, injury, damage or expense that I or my Child may suffer, incur or experience in connection with my Child's participation in the Program; and

2) I NOW RELEASE the VPD Group from any and all liability for any complaints, demands, claims, actions, suits, judgments and orders for any and all losses, injuries, damage or expenses I or my Child may suffer, incur or experience in connection with my Child's participation in the Program; and



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3) FOR MYSELF, I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY the VPD Group for and hold it harmless from any and all losses, injuries, damages and expenses of any kind that the VPD Group may suffer, incur or experience and for any and all complaints, demands, claims, actions, suits, judgments and orders for any and all losses, injuries, damages or expenses of any kind anyone else may suffer, incur or experience in connection with my Child's participation in the Program.

In signing this document and permitting my Child to participate in the Program, I do not rely upon any oral or written statements, promises or other communications made by VPD Group other than as set out in this document. This document will be exclusively governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of British Columbia and no court outside of British Columbia will have any jurisdiction over this Consent, the Program, or any of the matters arising from them.

CONSENT AND RELEASE FOR PHOTOGRAPHS

I now irrevocably consent to and waive all claims for compensation and release the City of Vancouver, Vancouver Police Board, VPD and each of their respective officials, officers, employees and representatives (collectively, the "VPD") from any and all liability which may arise as a result of my child being photographed while participating in the Cadet Program, and for the subsequent use and display of the photographs in any media.

For clarity I, the undersigned parent or legal guardian of the Cadet applicant, now irrevocably consent to my child being photographed, by professional and/or amateur photographers, while participating in any detail, event, function, or activity related to the Cadet Program. I also give my consent for the VPD, including any of its divisions or units to use the photographs taken of my child to develop and display, in any media, brochures, posters, displays, or other items for the Cadet Recruitment purposes. I further authorize the use and display, in any media, of the photographs during other VPD sponsored promotional activity.
